NOTICE

Kind Attention: Recyclers and Producers under the "Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023"

The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has notified Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 8 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 vide notification number G.S.R. 338(E), dated the 18th May, 2023 and the said Rules came into force from 1st April, 2024.

Under the said Rules, the Used Oil Recyclers are required to generate EPR Certificates through the EPR Portal for Used Oil Management and Producers are required to fulfil their EPR obligations through purchase the EPR certificates. Therefore, in this regard:

- For generation of EPR Certificate on the EPR Used Oil Portal, the recyclers are required to maintain records of sales of recycled product through invoice linked to GST.
- The registered Recyclers not having arrangement for GST linked invoice shall register for GST e-invoicing immediately as the EPR certificates generated based on recycled product sales invoices other than the GST e-invoice will not be considered after 30th June, 2026. Such non-GST e-invoice based EPR certificates will be considered as false certificates and non-compliances under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023.
- The Producers shall also henceforth accept sales e-invoices linked to GST for recycled products from used oil recyclers.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
