In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 64 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 2024 (6 of 1974) and Section 54 of the Amended Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 2024 (14 of 1981) and based on the "Control of Water Pollution (Grant, Refusal or Cancellation of Consent) Guidelines 2025" Notified by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) vide GSR No.85(E), dated 30.01.2025 & "Control of Air Pollution (Grant, Refusal or Cancellation of Consent) Guidelines 2025" Notified by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) vide GSR No.84(E), dated 30.01.2025, the State Government after consultation with the State Board do hereby prescribe the Annual Consent Fee to be accompanied with the application for Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate for industries, mines, local bodies, infrastructure projects, aquaculture and Diesel Generator sets.

**PART- A : Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate"**

**1. Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for Industrial Plants**

(a) The annual fee for grant of Consent to Operate is determined based on the capital investment and categorization of the industrial plant, using the following formula, as follows: -

$$CF = CI \times SF \times PIF \times SSF$$

Where,

- CF : Annual Fee for Consent to Operate (in Rs.)
- CI : Capital Investment(in Rs.)
- SF : Scale Factor (based on Capital Investment)
- PIF : Pollution Index Factor (based on category)
- SSF : State Specific Factor

(b) Capital Investment:

- i. The investment made on fixed assets i.e. Land, Buildings including Staff quarters, Guest Houses, etc. within industrial premises (or) township, plants & machinery and equipment including the cost of investment on Pollution Control without depreciation.

- ii. In the case of an industry operating on lease land and / or building or any other assets, ten (10) times the annual lease value is to be taken as equivalent to Capital Investment (or) Guidance Value of property / land, whichever is higher.

(c) The Scale Factor (SF) according to capital investment slabs is as under: -

(d) The Pollution Index Factor (PIF) based on categorization of Industry is as under: -

(e) The State Specific Factor (SSF) based on categorization of Industry and capital investment slab is as under: -

## 2. Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for Mining Projects:

(a) The annual fee for grant of Consent to Operate for mining project / activity will be determined based on the consented capacity of the mineral to be mined, the type of mineral, the mining area, and the type of mining. The fee shall be calculated using the following formula -

$$CF = CC \times MF \times AF \times TMF$$

Where,

- CF: Annual Consent to Operate fee (in Rs.)
- CC: Consented Capacity of Mineral to be mined (in Tonne / Annum)
- MF: Mineral Factor (based on type of Mineral)
- AF: Area Factor (based on mining area)
- TMF: Type of Mining Factor (based on type of mining)

(b) The Mineral Factor (MF) based on type of minerals mined are:

### 3. Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for local bodies and infrastructure projects (residential and others)

(a) These projects include Residential (Standalone Apartment / Complexes), Other than Residential (Layouts, Integrated Projects, Commercial Complex, Office Complex, Education Institutions, Township) and Local Bodies including Water Supply and Sewerage Board.

The capital investment for the purpose of determining fee for consent to establish w.r.t. infrastructure projects, as covered under the notification of the Government of India number S.O.1533 (E), dated the 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2006, as amended from time to time, shall be based on the capital investment during the establishment phase using the formula adopted for the industrial plants, as above at Para-1 above.

(b) The annual fee for consent to operate of the projects at sub Para (a) above, shall be based on the quantity of sewage generated as given below: -

### 4. Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for Aqua Culture activities

The annual fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for Aqua Culture activities shall be determined based on the lease hold area, as follows.

**5. Annual Fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" for Diesel Generator (as the only source)**

For any industrial plant having diesel generator set as the only source of air pollution, the annual fees for grant of "Consent to Operate" will be as under.

**Part- B: Fee for Consent to Establish**


The fees for obtaining consent to establish shall be twice the annual fee for the grant of "Consent to Operate" as prescribed in Part- A above.

"Consent to Establish" Fees = 2 x Annual Fees for Consent to Operate

The State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, shall follow all other clauses prescribed in the Guidelines notified by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide Notification No. G.S.R.84(E), dated 29.01.2025 and No.G.S.R.85(E), dated 30.01.2025 as such.

This order shall take effect immediately.
