



Office Order

The State Board has issued Office Order No.- F-12(IEC-83) RSPCB/Project/1560-1565 dated 17.08.2023, prescribing provisions for setting up of Continuous Tyre Pyrolysis Units in the State, wherein the following provision was stipulated:-

"Minimum aerial distance of 500 meter shall be ensured between two Tyre Pyrolysis units".

The matter was reviewed in light of representations received from industrial units. Further, in line with the SOP issued by CPCB on 16.01.2024 for recycling of waste tyre scrap, the State Board has decided to partially modify the aforesaid Office Order dated 17.08.2023, and accordingly, the provision regarding minimum aerial distance of 500 meters between two Tyre Pyrolysis Units is hereby omitted.

Further, it has also been decided that all pending as well as the upcoming applications for Consent to Establish for setting up of Continuous Tyre Pyrolysis Units shall be processed accordingly.

All other provisions/conditions stipulated under Office Order dated 17.08.2023 shall remain unchanged and continue to remain in force.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
