OFFICE ORDER

The Election Commission of India vide their communication dated 16.03.2026 has announced General Elections for Legislative Assemblies of West Bengal (Phase-II) to be held on 29.04.2026 (Wednesday) to be declared as "PAID HOLIDAY" under section 135(B) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Accordingly, all Employers of Industrial Establishments/Factories/Shops /Commercial Establishments/Institutions operating in the National Capital Territory of Delhi shall grant a "PAID HOLIDAY" to their employees who are electors of General Legislative Assemblies Elections, 2026 of West Bengal (Phase-II) to enable them to cast their vote on the day of polling i.e. 29.04.2026 (Wednesday), in case the scheduled day is a working day for the concerned Employees/Electors.

Non-compliance of the above directions shall attract action as per the relevant provisions of law.


