Highlights of Retail Supply Tariff Order for FY 2026-27 issued on 26th March, 2026

- 1) Only 4.80% tariff hike allowed against proposed hike of 10.19%.
- 2) No Tariff hike for Seasonal (HV-4) and Metro Rail (HV-9) Consumers.
- 3) Minimum charges for all LV categories and HV-4: Seasonal category have already been abolished. In this order, Minimum charges for the following HV categories are also abolished:
 - a) Irrigation, Public Water Works and Other than Agricultural (HV-5);
 - b) Bulk Residential Users (HV-6); and
 - c) Metro Rail (HV 9).
- 4) kWh billing continued for HT/EHT consumers.
- 5) Night -Time ToD rebate for HT/EHT consumers to continue.
- 6) No metering charges for consumers.
- 7) Rebates/incentives available for new and existing HT/EHT connections to continue with slight modifications.
- 8) Rebates/Incentives available to consumers with pre-paid meters to continue.
- 9) Other Rebates/Incentives available to consumers for LV and HT/EHT consumers to continue.
- 10) Rebates/incentives for prompt/online bill payment to continue.
- 11) Incentives for load factor/power factor to continue.
- 12) Discounted tariff for smart meter consumers: 20% rebate on energy charge during solar hours to continue.
- 13) Reduction in Green Energy Tariff for reducing carbon foot prints by consumers.
- 14) Reduction in Additional Surcharge for Open Access Consumers.
- 15) DISCOMs to get R&D funds for undertaking studies in the areas of technological intervention, operational efficiency improvement and cost saving.
