Sub: Onboarding of Unified Consent & Authorisation Monitoring System (UCAMS) – Reg.

In pursuance of the ongoing digitalisation initiatives of the Lakshadweep Pollution Control Committee (LPCC) and with a view to streamlining the processing of applications, enhancing transparency and facilitating online delivery of regulatory services under the applicable environmental legislations, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the Unified Consent & Authorisation Monitoring System (UCAMS), a pan-India online portal developed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), has been on boarded by the Lakshadweep Pollution Control Committee with effect from 21st August, 2026.

Accordingly, all applications relating to the following shall be submitted online through the UCAMS portal with effect from the above date:

1. Consent to Establish (CTE);
2. Consent to Operate (CTO);
3. Renewal of Consent; and
4. Authorisation under the applicable environmental Acts and Rules.

Applicants may access the UCAMS portal and submit their applications through: <https://ucams.cpcb.gov.in>

All industries, establishments and other activities requiring Consent/ Authorisation from the Lakshadweep Pollution Control Committee under the applicable environmental Acts and Rules are hereby advised to register on the UCAMS portal and submit their applications, along with the requisite documents and prescribed fees, through the online system.

Submission of applications through the manual/offline mode shall be discontinued with effect from 21.08.2026. Applicants may contact the UCAMS Helpdesk for technical assistance at 011-43102497 / 011-43102498 or through email at helpdesk-ucams.cpcb@gov.in.

All concerned are requested to make use of the UCAMS portal for submission and processing of Consent/Authorisation applications.
