NOTIFICATION

The 25th September, 2025

No. E-648064/50.- The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Assam Factories Rules, 1950, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, which the Governor of Assam proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948), for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules shall be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of the period of 30 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules before the expiry of the period specified above, shall be considered by the Governor of Assam.

Draft rules

Short title and
Commencement

- (1) These rules may be called the Assam Factories (Amendment), Rule, 2025.
- (2) They shall extend to the whole of the State of Assam.
- (3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of rule 7

2. In the principal Rules, in rule 7, after sub-rule (2), the following new sub-rule (2a) shall be inserted, namely:-

"(2a) The process of renewal of factory licence shall be fully automated and instantaneous subject to the payment of renewal of fees as per Schedule A, B and C of rule 5 through the designated online system under Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) Portal. The renewed factory licence shall be in force for a period of 10 years from the date of renewal."

Amendment of Rule 94 : 3.

- In the principal Rules, in rule 94,
 - (i) in Schedule II and III in clause 3, the words "women and" and "woman" shall be deleted.

- (ii) in Schedule IV and VI, in clause 4, the words "women and" and "woman" shall be deleted.
- (iii) in Schedule VII, in clause 1, the words "women and" and "woman" shall be deleted.
- (iv) in Schedule VIII, in clause 2, in the second proviso, in the first line, the words "woman or" shall be deleted.
- (v) in Schedule X, in clause 5, in the first line, the words "woman or" shall be deleted.
- (vi) in Schedule XI, in Part-II, in clause 6, the words "and women" and "and women" shall be deleted.
- (vii) in Schedule XII, in clause 4, the words "women and" and "women or" shall be deleted.
- (viii) in Schedule XIV, in clause 6, the words "women and and "women of shall be deleted.
- (ix) in Schedule XV, in clause 15, the words "women and" and "women or" shall be deleted.
- (x) in Schedule XIX, in clause 6, the words "women and" and "women or" shall be deleted.
- (xi) in Schedule XX, in clause 5, the words "women or" wherever they occur shall be deleted.
- (xii) in Schedule XXII, in clause 8, the words "woman and" and "women or" shall be deleted.
