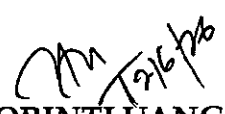

Guidelines regarding establishment of telecommunication network on property other than public property – Procedure for intimation and acknowledgement on the Right of Way Portal

1. The facility provider shall, at the time of submission of intimation under rule 15 of the Telecommunication (Right of Way) Rules, 2024, in respect of immovable property other than public property on the designated portal, furnish an undertaking confirming the authenticity and validity of all documents submitted, including the structural safety certificate. The undertaking shall also state that submission of any incorrect, false or misleading information or document shall be treated as a violation of the relevant license / authorisation granted by the Central Government and shall attract action under applicable provisions of law. Necessary provision in this regard shall be made on the Right of Way (RoW) Portal.
2. An acknowledgement shall be auto-generated on submission of the aforesaid intimation on the RoW Portal, to enable the facility provider to commence work.
3. The designated public entity shall examine the intimation submitted under sub-rule (4) of rule 15 *ibid.* within a period of fifteen days from the date of submission on the RoW Portal. The scope of such examination shall be limited to verification of the structural safety certificate and the authorisation of the certifying engineer.
4. The designated public entity may seek clarification or additional documents, limited only to aspects relating to structural safety certification, and such clarification shall be sought only once. A period of seven days shall be provided to the facility provider for submission of the same.
5. Where clarification or additional documents are sought, the examination shall be completed within fifteen days from the initial submission or within seven days from the date of receipt of such clarification/documents, whichever is later.
6. In case the facility provider fails to submit the requisite clarification/documents within the stipulated period, the intimation shall be treated as incomplete and invalid.
7. In case any document or information submitted is subsequently found to be incorrect, false, or misleading —
 - (a) the same shall be treated as a violation of the relevant license or authorisation;
 - (b) appropriate action shall be taken as per applicable laws, including those of the State or Union Territory concerned;
 - (c) the public entity concerned may take necessary action in accordance with law, and any financial loss arising therefrom shall be borne by the facility provider.
