PUBLIC NOTICE

Environment Protection (End-of-Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has notified Environment Protection (End-of-Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025 under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 vide notification no: S.O. 98(E) dated January 6, 2025 for implementation of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for End-of-Life Vehicles (ELVs). These rules came into force from 1st April, 2025, to regulate the management, recycling, and disposal of ELVs in an environmentally sustainable manner through Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR). These rules apply to Producers, Registered Owners of Vehicles, Bulk Consumers, Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs), Collection Centers, and Automated Testing Stations. They cover all vehicle types defined under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, including electric and battery-operated vehicles, but exclude agricultural tractors, trailers, power tillers and combine harvesters.

As per Environment Protection (End-of-Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025, all stakeholders, namely Producer, Bulk Consumers and Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs) are required to register on the CPCB EPR Portal and ensure compliance with the following:

1. Registration shall be done on the CPCB EPR Portal at <https://eprelv.cpcb.gov.in/>
2. No commercial activity shall be undertaken by any Producer, Bulk Consumers and Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs) without registration on the Central Pollution Control Board's (CPCB) EPR portal. Any commercial activity conducted outside of the portal is strictly prohibited.

The roles and responsibilities of authorities and stakeholders are prescribed under the Environment Protection (End-of-Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025.

RVSFs carrying out operation without valid consent to operate are hereby directed to cease operations immediately and apply online for CTE and CCA through the GPCB XGN Portal under the prevailing consent mechanism.

All concerned stakeholders are hereby directed to ensure strict compliance with the Environment Protection (End-of-Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025. Any non-compliance shall attract action under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
