CIRCULAR

Sub: All registered factories operating Ambulance / OHC Centers in Karnataka need to be registered under **“Karnataka Private Medical Establishments Act”** – Reg.

Applicable registered factories falling under the purview of Rule 88 & Rules 92 of Karnataka Factories rules,1969 compulsorily need to provide Occupational Health Centre and Ambulance Room respectively.

In continuation to this, as per the Karnataka Private Medical Establishment Act, 2007, all Health Centre in order improve and promote the quality of Health Care need be registered under the said act.

In view of this, department thought that if OHC / Ambulance Room registered under KPME Act will undergo applicable inspections which will indirectly promote efficient management of the workers' health at the health centers.

In the context of all the above, Field Officers should initiate actions to advice factory management to register all OHC / Ambulance room falling under his / her jurisdiction to register under KPME Act in consultation with District Health and Family Welfare Department and should also provide detail of factories registered under the said act to the authority.
